Former Homosexual Headlines 2nd Annual ECP Centre Fundraiser

(Burlington - May 31, 2005) The ECP Centre's 2nd annual fundraiser is taking place Friday, June 24. Internationally renowned speaker, Stephen Bennett, is headlining the event. The money raised will go towards the legal fees of Christian hero and freedom fighter Chris Kempling and towards the ongoing work of the ECP Centre.

"This is a fantastic opportunity for Christians to rally together and help a persecuted brother who is standing in the gap and support the ongoing work of Equipping Christians," said executive director, Tristan Emmanuel.

Chris Kempling is a BC teacher who is being vigorously persecuted, harassed and intimidated over a personal letter to the editor. Kempling's personal and compassionate views raised the ire of the BCCT (the British Columbia College of Teachers), which has suspended him without pay. This is the same organisation that dragged Trinity Western University through the court system all the way up to the Supreme Court of Canada several years ago.

Stephen Bennett is a happily married Christian father with a passion to reach out to homosexuals who want to escape the lifestyle. Mr. Bennett is a former homosexual, so

he speaks from personal experience and with great empathy to homosexuals. "Mr. Bennett's message is one that the church, politicians and Canadian society needs to hear," said Rev. Emmanuel. "All Christians involved in the battle for marriage and the family will want to hear what Mr. Bennett has to say."

The ECP Center is taking a leadership role in the fight for marriage in Canada. The Centre has recently received significant media coverage across Canada. "Activity in Nova Scotia and a marriage rally at Queen's Park in Ontario have caused the Canadian political establishment to sit up and take notice," said Rev. Emmanuel. "The Canadian political establishment is waking up to the fact that they cannot take pro-marriage Canadians for granted," Rev. Emmanuel stressed.
